What is Sage Catalyst?





- 1 Go to the Explore tab to see all the titles available to you.
- 2 The books are categorized by recommended titles, recently added, and by discipline.
- 3 Scroll down to see the discipline categories.
- 4 Use the search function to find a specific title. You can also search for content in the book or your notes here.
- 5 Click on “borrow” to add the title to your personal Library page.
- 6 Go to the “My Library” page to find the titles you borrowed.

Navigating the eReader

eReader view

- 1 Browse the table of contents.
- 2 Find bibliographic information and add citations.
- 3 Search within the book for specific words and phrases.
- 4 Set your reader preferences.
- 5 Create annotations by simply selecting a part of the text and choosing an action. Highlight the text, add notes, copy & paste create a flashcard, or read aloud from a given location.
- 6 Go to your Workbook to see annotations, bookmarks, and flashcards you created.
- 7 Download the app for online access and study.
